Sorry in advance but this is long.

Thank you for your response. Your kitties are beautiful but they certainly look like they are from different litters. My kittie looks just like your Milo but he is a chocolate point. I was also told, by way of the pedigree that cats brighteye was his dam but after questioning the fact I couldn't find any pictures of her was then told that in fact his dam was kinta. He sent me a picture supposedly of kinta but after looking at pictures on his Facebook discovered that picture wasn't kinta but in fact another cat. I also seen where he had posted an ad for kittens and my kitten was posted as a kitten of Pong??? In my search for a siamese I wanted a modern, wedge type as that is what my prior cat was. We had to put her asleep at 16 years of age due to declining health and it left me heartbroken. I wasn't so concerned over the pedigree but wanted a true bred modern type so wanted to see the parents. My take on it is he has a lot more females that he breeds that he doesn't show any pictures of because they aren't breeding quality. I, like you, did my reasearch and was lead to believe he was in fact pure modern type but after finding pictures of "pong" she looked mixed with Applehead, maybe even not full siamese. I wish I would have screenshot it all because it has been removed from his page.

Also my little guy came to me with no fleas, and in fairly good health which leads me to believe that either our kittens are from different litters or he bathed my kitten with flea shampoo and treated him before sending him and didn't yours. I also got my kittie a full month before you too and he may have moved them to a not as clean part of the cattery. I received him on April 2 and he was suppose to have been 13 weeks but my vet guessed him at closer to 10 weeks. We didn't do vaccines at that visit because I was just doing a well check. A few weeks later I noticed he was beginning to get a cough so I took him in and the vet said he sounded clear so we proceeded with vaccines. He had a severe reaction to the FVRCP. Which only meant one thing, he hadn't been vaccinated before because a reaction would have been noted. His reaction left him temporary paralyzed and not eating or drinking. He had to stay at the vet for steroid shot and fluids. After about 5 days he was back to normal but his cough was worse. I took a video and showed the vet and she said it looked like feline asthma that we would have to watch it. I ask was it hereditary and she said it could be. He has now been neutered and his cough is still there but only once every few days.

I have been in contact with Mr. Peltier. I told about my kitten "ollie" being sick due to vaccines and he didn't say anything about it. I am the type if person to just keep my mouth shut and be nice. I guess I shouldn't be. Before I heard back from you he had talked with me about this situation and that the USDA had been to his house and I told him I could write a letter only stating the facts about my experience about my kitten being flea free and so on but I did mention I would also have to include about the pedigree being wrong and I haven't heard back from him. This was before I realized he had to be lying about the shots because of my kittens reactions. He is on my friends list on fb. I noticed the young wife thing and was wondering same as you about him being scammed our if money and a way for them to come into the US. I think maybe he is breeding for money now instead of betterment of the breed. Especially since he cannot tell the truth about the age and dam's identity. I am beginning to wonder if he even knows/remembers.
