PHYSICAL EXAM FINDINGS:

BAR, mm pk/CRT<2sec. Heart and lungs auscult normally, mild referred upper respiratory noise. Abdomen soft/non-painful. Lymph nodes normal. Ambulatory x4, no ataxia/lameness. Cranial nerves normal. Large amount of live fleas. Urogenital system normal. EENT clear. Mild bilateral mucoid ocular discharge. Euhydrated.

ASSESSMENT:

URI Fleas

PLAN:

Don't want to vaccinate today since just was transported by plane and potentially has URI. Clavamox drops (62.5mg/mL) 0.5 mL PO BID x 7 days. Capstar 2-25# single dose PO. Feline Drontal 1 tab PO once. O has Frontline plus, will apply at home. Recheck in 7 days for vaccinations.

BAR, mm pk/CRT<2sec. Heart and lungs auscult normally. Abdomen soft/non-painful, Lymph nodes normal. Ambulatory x4, no ataxia/lameness. Large amount of live fleas noted. Urogenital system normal, intact male. EENT clear. Mild mucoid discharge OS. Euhydrated. Temp: ~~ Pulse: 240 RR: 35 Weight: 4#

ASSESSMENT:

Fleas R/o early URI

PLAN:

P's littermate (also just adopted) has URI, so going to treat p with antibiotics as well. Don't want to vaccinate today since just was transported by plane and potentially has URI. Clavamox drops (62.5 mg/mL) $0.5 \text{ mL PO BID} \times 7$ days. Capstar 2-25# single dose PO. Feline Drontal 1 tab PO once. O has Frontline plus, will apply at home. Recheck in 7 days for vaccinations.
